Kathleen Winter is the author of three prize-winning poetry books: *Transformer*, a finalist for the Northern California Book Awards; *I will not kick my friends*; and *Nostalgia for the Criminal Past*. Her poems and short fiction appear in *The New Statesman*, *The New Republic*, *Poetry London*, *Yale Review*, *Massachusetts Review*, *Michigan Quarterly Review*, *Agni*, *Gigantic Sequins*, and *Five Points*. Awards include the Poetry Society of America Emily Dickinson Award, Rochelle Ratner Memorial Prize, and the Ralph Johnston Fellowship. Kathleen was granted fellowships by the Sewanee Writers' Conference, Maison Dora Maar, James Merrill House, Cill Rialaig, and the Heinrich Böll House. She's an associate editor for the literary magazine *32 Poems* and has taught writing at SSU since 2017.
