

ENGLISH EDUCATION PATHWAY (English Single Subject Matter Program)

This is a **suggested** pattern for completing the English Single Subject Matter Program requirements. This is not the only way this program can be completed; this worksheet provides a suggested way to move through the requirements. Completing the program with a 3.0 GPA (and no less than a C in any course) will certify you as “Subject Matter Competent” to teach English at the secondary level and will waive the need to take the California state CSET exam to enter a Single Subject teaching credential program.
