Kathleen Winter is the author of three prize-winning poetry books, including *Transformer*, a finalist for the 2021 Northern California Book Awards; *I will not kick my friends*; and *Nostalgia for the Criminal Past*. Her poems and fiction appear in *The New Statesman*, *The New Republic*, *Poetry London*, *Yale Review*, *Massachusetts Review*, *Michigan Quarterly Review*, *Colorado Review*, *Volt*, *Gigantic Sequins*, and *Five Points*. She won the Poetry Society of America Emily Dickinson Award, the Rochelle Ratner Memorial Prize, and the Ralph Johnston Fellowship. She was awarded fellowships by the Sewanee Writers' Conference; the Maison Dora Maar in Provence, France; James Merrill House; and Vermont Studio Center. Kathleen is an associate editor for the journal *32 Poems*. She's taught writing at SSU since 2017.
